On January 20, 2016, the DuPage Mayors and Managers Conference approved its Legislative Action Program for 2016. At the start of each legislative session, the Conference focuses its efforts by selecting key legislative priorities which have significant and immediate impacts on municipalities and their residents. The Conference actively pursues these legislative priorities through initiating legislation, strong advocacy, and cooperation with partner organizations.

This year, the Conference identified six legislative priorities for inclusion in the 2016 Legislative Action Program:

- Protect Local Revenue
- Reform Municipal Public Safety Pensions
- Amend the Public Safety Employee Benefits Act (PSEBA)
- Amend the Workers’ Compensation Act
- Remove Barriers of Non-Home Rule Authority
- Support True Western Access
