II. COMMITTEE DISCUSSION

1. 2023-2027 Call for Projects

The 2023-2027 Call for Projects opened on January 13 and will close on March 15. Applications must be submitted through CMAP's eTIP. In addition to filling out the eTIP, applicants must upload the appropriate supplemental scoring form (Roadway or Trail), a detailed cost estimate, and any documentation needed to verify application status (freight zoning map, confirmation of Phase I engineering status, etc.) The supplemental scoring forms can be found on [DMMC's website](#). 2. STP Local Update/Letting Status

Milton Township's Lambert Road project previously requested and received a six-month extension, which was approved by the Committee in April 2021. This pushed the last possible letting for the project to April 2022. The accompanying correspondence requests a second six-month extension. This request is contrary to CMAP's Active Program Management (APM) guidelines and cannot be considered. If the project is not let by April 2022 the funding will revert to the CMAP redistributive fund. Milton Township has been advised that the request is not allowed under APM.

3. 2022 STP Application - State Route Approval

The City of Elmhurst is planning to apply for DMMC STP funding as part of the 2022 Call for Projects for an intersection improvements project located at IL

Route 83/Riverside Drive/Monroe Drive. The project is federal-aid eligible and located on a state route (IL 83). DMMC STP policy requires Committee approval for a roadway project located on a state route to apply for STP funding. If the request is approved by the Committee, the project will be evaluated with all other projects submitted during the Call for Projects. A conceptual plan of the intersection improvements is attached.

4. FFY 2025 STP Additional Funding Increase Request

The Fullerton Resurfacing Project between Schmale Road and Bloomingdale Road in the Village of Glendale Heights previously applied for an amount of \$897,687 at a 60/40 split. Due to the project's score and limited availability of funding at the time, the project received \$501,084. Glendale Heights has requested Committee consideration for a cost increase at the original funding request, an increase of \$396,603. DMMC has confirmed the availability of funding for this request with CMAP. Committee consideration of the cost increase is requested.
