IV. COMMITTEE DISCUSSION

A. CMAP Transportation Call for Projects

May noted that CMAP's call for STP Shared Fund, CMAQ, CRP, and TAP projects is open through December 20, 2024 and that CMAP is hosting an informational webinar about the Call on Wednesday, October 30 at 10:00 am.

B. Proposed January 2025 Special Meeting

May explained that a special meeting is needed so the DuPage Council can provide subregional priority points for proposed STP Shared Fund Projects that would provide transportation benefits to DuPage County. A motion was made by Grabowski, seconded by Lagvankar approving a special meeting on Wednesday, January 29 at 9:30 a.m. The motion carried.

C. STP Shared Fund Subregional Priority Points

May noted that the Committee is asked to consider recommending approval of the process to award DMMC's subgregional priority points.

He shared that there is one proposed change to the process that omits language regarding the consideration of Shared Fund applications whose project limits are entirely outside of DuPage County. Since the Committee is unlikely to award points to projects from Councils other than DuPage, the thought is to save applicants whose projects do not impact the Council the time and effort of preparing and giving a

presentation and reduce the administrative burden on the Council to have to review those projects.

May explained that the process otherwise remains unchanged. Applicants will be given 10 minutes to present to the Committee and discuss their project. Each municipality and one representative from DuPage County that is present at the special meeting will be allowed to give 5 points that can be allocated to any of the applications in a partial or full amount. Only one vote per municipality is allowed. The application that receives the most points will be recommended to receive 5 bonus points, the application that receives the second most points will be recommended to receive 4 bonus points, and so on. The Committee's recommendation for the allocation of bonus points will go to the Board of Directors for final approval at the February 6 meeting.

A motion was made by Guerra, seconded by Sianis, to recommend approval of the awarding process for DMMC's subregional priority points as presented. The motion carried.

D. Active Program Management and Redistribution

Pasquini presented an overview of Active Program Management policies related to regional redistribution funds. He explained that given the significant balance of these funds in the current federal fiscal year, the Council has potential opportunities to maximize their use for the DuPage program. A brief discussion was held on how to access these funds. The Committee agreed that this should remain an ongoing topic at meetings for the remainder of the federal fiscal year.

E. FFY 2025-2029 STP-L Program

May shared that the most up-to-date DuPage Council program spreadsheet is included in the packet. It was updated to reflect the cost increase requests approved at the August 22 committee meeting for Hanover Park's Schick Road Resurfacing project and Bloomingdale's Fairfield Way Resurfacing project.

V. <u>STAFF REPORTS</u>

Pasquini shared that the 2024 STP Shared Fund, CMAQ/CRP, and TAP Workshop was held on September 26 at Oak Brook Village Hall with 27 attendees.
